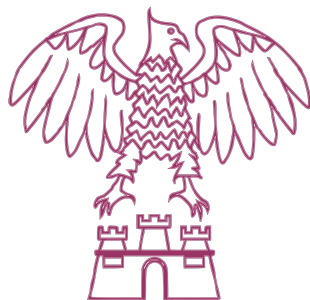

ALPS - A-Level Performance Systems

Just as important as looking at league tables or A Level grades and pass rates, are the 'value added' scores produced by the A Level Performance System (ALPS). ALPS measures the distance travelled by students from their GCSE grades at school to their final A Level grades. These 'value added' scores are the best way to compare student achievements in schools and colleges.

The ALPS data shows Caerleon's students consistently improve whilst studying here meaning that whatever a student's GCSE results, they will make fantastic progress at Caerleon – a great start to a successful future!

How it works

ALPS data is a system used by schools to determine value added outcomes. These outcomes are measured using a thermometer with grades from 1 to 9. The outcomes you will see below are the grades received for the school from the ALPS system. Red in ALPS means a high outcome (Your outcomes are Red Hot) conversely Blue means a lower outcome (Cold). The highest grade possible is a 1 with the lowest being 9. A grade of 1, 2 or 3 means the school has performed within or exceeded the top 25% of the national benchmark. A 4, 5 or 6 grade means performance is within the middle 50% of benchmark data. A 7, 8 or 9 means the performance is in the bottom 25% of benchmark data. The important data to look at here is the T score which ranks the school against all other schools nationally. We currently have an average over 3 years of 2.11 which places the school in the Top 25% nationally. It is important to note that these results are based on aspirational targets set by the ALPS software. They compare the students' GCSE outcomes against national data of students with similar GCSE outcomes. They then look at the Top 25% of those similar students and calculate the Target grade based on their outcomes.
