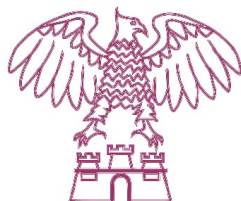

MAR 21

Students are given information on entrance exams such as BMAT (Bio-Med Science) UCAT (Medicine), Oxbridge exams. For these exams, you will need to enter independently & sit at test centres, but please ask if you are not sure.

Enrichment will continue to focus on skills needed to make competitive applications.

MAY 21

Students continue to complete the necessary research and activities in order to make these competitive applications.

JULY 21

Admission test window opens up and continues through to September. Students should continue to practice and work on these tests. Students should start looking at Moocs on UniFrog and beginning the process of completing a Mooc over the Summer holidays.

Students continue to develop Personal Statement and aim to complete the first draft by the start of Year 13.

OCT 21

Completed forms are sent to UCAS by the school as soon as they are ready. The deadline for this is Oct 15th. You will now receive communication directly from UCAS and not through the school. Conservatoire applications are submitted on Oct 1st.

DEC 21

MMI (Mock Medical Interviews) will need to be practiced. Resources will be provided to students to assist with this process.

Post Jan 22

Await offers and continue to work towards target grades.

NOV 2020 TO FEB 2020

Students are given plentiful opportunities to engage in talks, webinars and conferences to find out more about these competitive applications. Students start building a bank of super-curriculum opportunities and record them in UniFrog. This is the research phase to discover what it takes to apply for these courses

APR 21

Ongoing support available from the Sixth Form Team for this field. Students continue to record activities, skills and competencies in UniFrog that are needed to support these applications.

JUNE 21

Post AS Exams students should focus on preparation for any entrance exams they need to do. Alongside this will be the UCAS day where we will begin the application process and start writing the Personal Statement. By this point the student has completed a variety of super-curriculum activities that are recorded in UniFrog

SEPT 21

This is a very busy month for these candidates. AS results are entered into the UCAS application form. Students submit their Personal Statement to their supervisor or mentor for checking. Once checked it is uploaded to the system along with the choice of courses and institutions in UCAS. Students then pay and send the form. All of this needs to be completed by **Sept 27th**. This allows time for the 6th form team to fully check all applications for errors and to write the reference. Students might be asked to attend a reference interview at this point. It is also likely that your entrance exam will be in this month. If applying to conservatoire the deadline is **Sept 20th**.

NOV 21

Students start to research interview technique as these applications will likely require an interview before an offer is made.

JAN 22

Students will likely be called to interview at this point and continue to wait for offers
